



Turn on your RPA flow

This document explains how to activate or turn on your RPA workflows for production use.

Before you begin:

Utilize the Test and Debug feature to test your workflows before you turn them on for production. This ensures they work as expected before going live. [Learn more](#)


How to turn on your RPA flows

There are two ways to enable your RPA workflows for production:

1. Through the RPA Builder


Access the RPA builder page for your desired workflow.

Locate the toggle switch in the top-right corner and switch it on.



2. From My Flows

1. Navigate to the **My Flows** page.
2. Identify the workflow you intend to activate for production.
3. Activate the toggle switch beside the chosen workflow.



What happens when you turn on your RPA flows?

When you turn on your flows, they will execute whenever the configured trigger event occurs. Your workflows will run automatically until they encounter errors (which will automatically disable them after a certain number of re tries) or until you manually deactivate them. Monitor your Flow Limits

To keep track of your current execution limits and usage:

1. Go to your RPA account.
2. Click on your **profile picture** in the top right corner.

Exceeding Your Limits

If your current executions are exhausted, you have the option to purchase additional add-ons that will expand your plan's limits.

This additional capacity can then be used for your workflow executions. Please note that the execution limit will be reset every month. For example, if you've purchased the plan on 15 June, 2024, then the execution limit will be reset on the next renewal date, which is 15 July, 2024.
