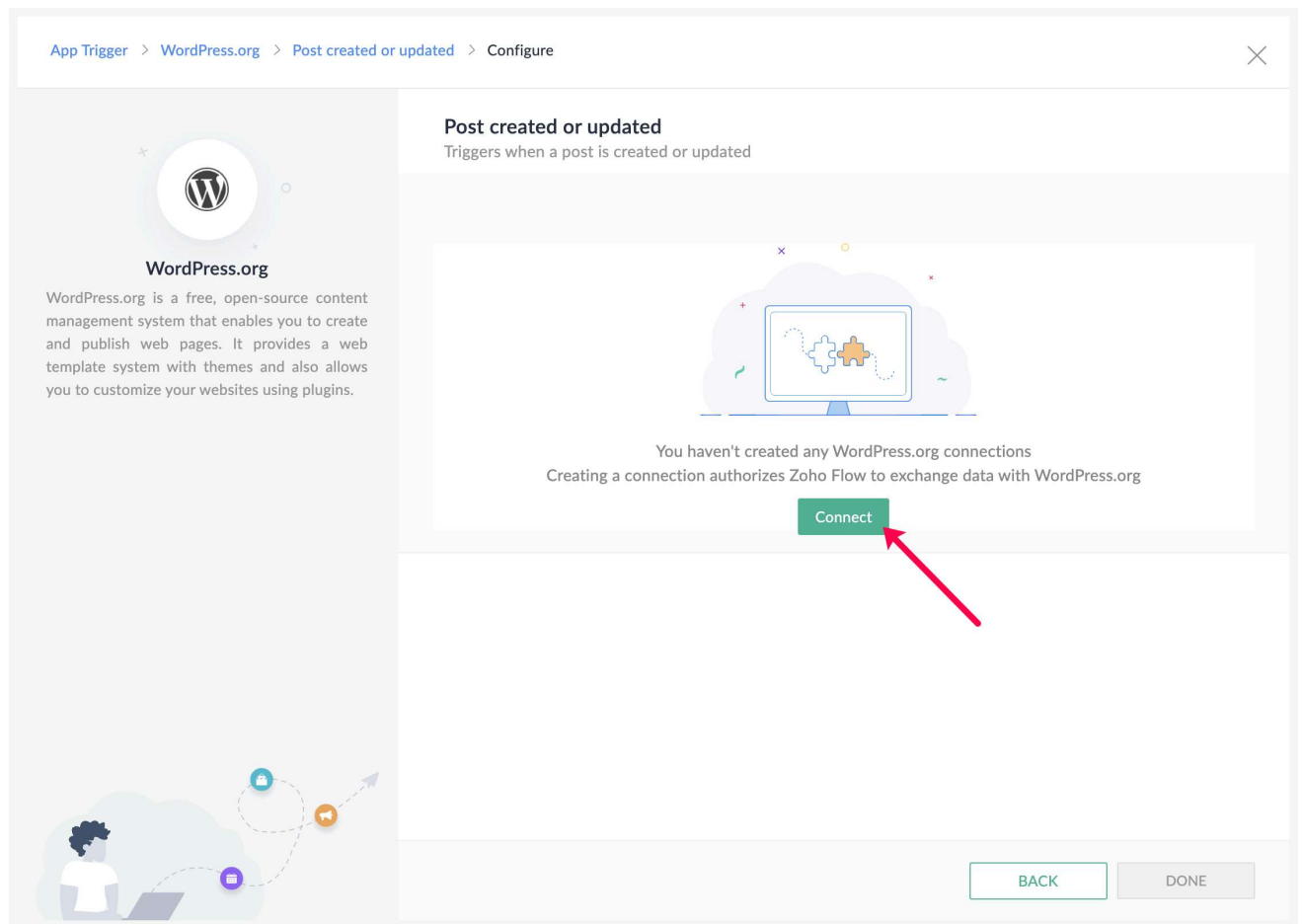
WordPress.org

What is WordPress.org?

WordPress.org is a free, open-source content management system that enables you to create and publish web pages. It provides a web template system with themes, and also allows you to customize your websites using plugins.

How to connect your WordPress.org account to Zoho Flow

1. Select the required trigger or action. If you select a trigger, click **Next**.
2. If there are no existing WordPress.org connections in your account, click **Connect**.
Otherwise, click **New**.



3. Alternatively, you can create a new connection by navigating to **Settings**, then **Connections**. Click **Create connection** and choose **WordPress.org**.
4. Enter a connection name.

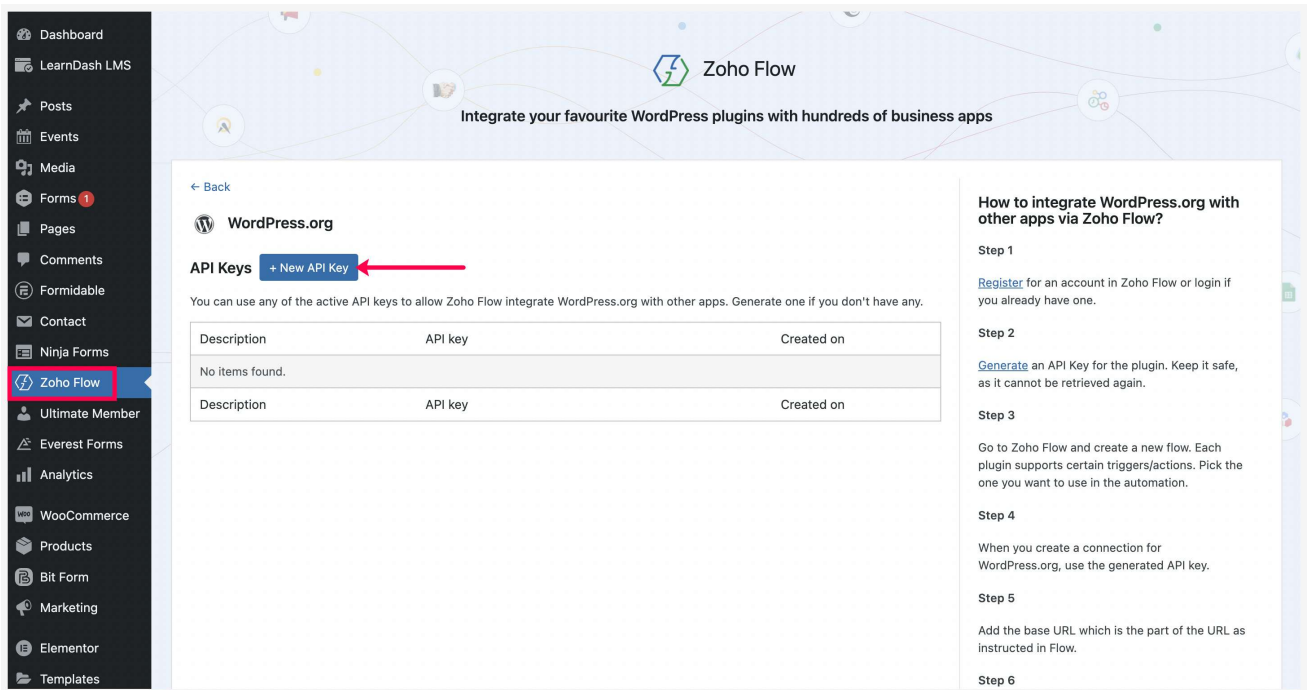
You will need the API key and the base URL of your WordPress website to proceed.

Finding the Base URL of your WordPress website

1. In a new browser tab, log in to your WordPress admin dashboard.
2. Navigate to the WP Admin dashboard, then click **Settings**, and then **General**. Next, click **Site address (URL)**.
3. Copy the URL (without the slash at the end) and paste it in the **Base URL** field in Zoho Flow.

Finding the API key

1. Return to your WP Admin dashboard.
2. Navigate to **Zoho Flow** on the sidebar menu, then click **Wordpress.org**.
3. Click **New API key**.



4. Provide a description for the API key, then click **Generate**.
5. Copy the key, then return to Zoho Flow and paste it in the **API key** field.

 **Note:** If you do not have the **Zoho Flow plugin** installed, navigate to **Plugins > Add new**. Search for Zoho Flow and click **Install now**. Continue to **step 2**.

Triggers and Actions in Zoho Flow

Triggers

Comment posted or edited

Use this trigger to send notifications when a new comment is posted on your webpage.

Post created or updated

Send emails or notifications, or update spreadsheets when a new post is created or updated.

User added or updated

This trigger lets you add new users to your newsletter list, CRM, or update their details in your database.

Actions

Create post

Automatically create new posts when content is added to your online storage, spreadsheet, or document using this action.

Create user

This action lets you create new users from your mail, chats, and more.

Fetch user

Using this action, you can get more details about an existing user using a unique identifier.

Update templated user

Update the details of an already configured templated user in WordPress.org.

Update user

Use this action to modify the details of an existing user.
